I want to take this opportunity to thank those of you who have already purchased the POW/MIA logo pull-tabs from Game Tab Ltd. – and to ask those of you who have not done so yet – to please start!

The National League of POW/MIA Families is the only national organization with voting membership comprised solely of relatives of Americans missing and unaccounted for in Southeast Asia. Established in Washington, DC in May of 1970, the League is a 501©3 organization, and maintains its original three-fold purpose: to obtain the release of all POWs, the fullest possible accounting of the Missing in Action, and the return of all recoverable remains of those Americans who died while serving our nation in Southeast Asia.

As one of the founding members of the League, I am often amazed that we are still a viable organization – almost forty years later. My brother, LTC Kevin J. McManus, USAF, ret., was released during Operation Homecoming in February of 1973 – after serving almost six years as a POW – but the League was founded to get as many answers as possible – and there are still answers to be had – so I continue to serve – both as an elected board member and as the League's Treasurer.

Since Operation Homecoming, 848 Americans have been identified and returned home for burial on US soil – putting an end to the suffering for that many families. But I firmly believe that there are many more of the 1,798 missing (as of 10/15/06) who can be accounted for – but doing so takes funds. Funds to keep the League a feasible association – to enable us to keep pressure on the governments of Southeast Asia as well as our own government.

We receive no funding from the federal government – our funds come from our members and from citizens like you. The League is also eligible for the Combined Federal Campaign – number 1174. CFC has very stringent standards, and I am extremely pleased that we qualify each year. The funds raised, through all means, are used by the League primarily for Public Awareness and Education.

So, your purchase of the POW/MIA pull-tabs benefits more than just the end consumer – the League benefits as well because Universal Manufacturing donates a portion of their proceeds to us.
